PRODUCTION CONTROLLER

Reporting to the Production Control Manager, this position is responsible for scheduling and coordinating work to the shop floor and procuring shop supplies in a manufacturing environment.

Major Responsibilities

- Authorizes work to the shop floor by releasing, printing, and delivering the production orders using MRP outputs
- Schedules production and develops priorities for those resources assigned to them by interpreting demands and analyzing their effects at the shop floor resource level
- Resolves schedule problems and helps coordinate solutions by monitoring production and reporting to manufacturing operations the bottlenecks, and requirements for resolving these constraints
- Prepares reports and charts reporting on production weekly progress
- Maintain item master information (order quantities and planner codes)
- Works in partnership with Production Managers and Supervisors
- Other duties as assigned

Qualifications

- Post secondary degree or diploma in Operations Management
- Minimum 3 to 5 years of Production Control experience in a manufacturing environment
- Good working knowledge of MRP and BOM information
- Excellent English written and verbal communication skills
